FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR?

You are required to pay for your flight to and from Australia, transportation, accommodations, cell plan and insurance. But do not worry, EnvoyGolf is there to assist in coordinating all of these including banking.

Q2 HOW LONG WOULD I BE IN AUSTRALIA?

In an ideal world, you would leave shortly after
Thanksgiving and return before Easter. There is some
flexibility to this but the longer the stay, the easier it is
to offset the cost of flying to Australia.

Q3 WHERE WILL I BE PLACED?

In the application form, you choose the regions of Australia where you want to work and then we only send your application form to those regions. Eventually, you will meet with the Superintendent and then like any other hire, you and the Superintendent will determine if it's a fit.

WILL IT ACTUALLY COST ME MONEY TO WORK IN AUSTRALIA?

You will be paid a slightly higher wage to help offset those other costs. While you wont get rich in this program, the wages should more than offset the extra costs to allow you to enjoy the experience and see the region/country.
